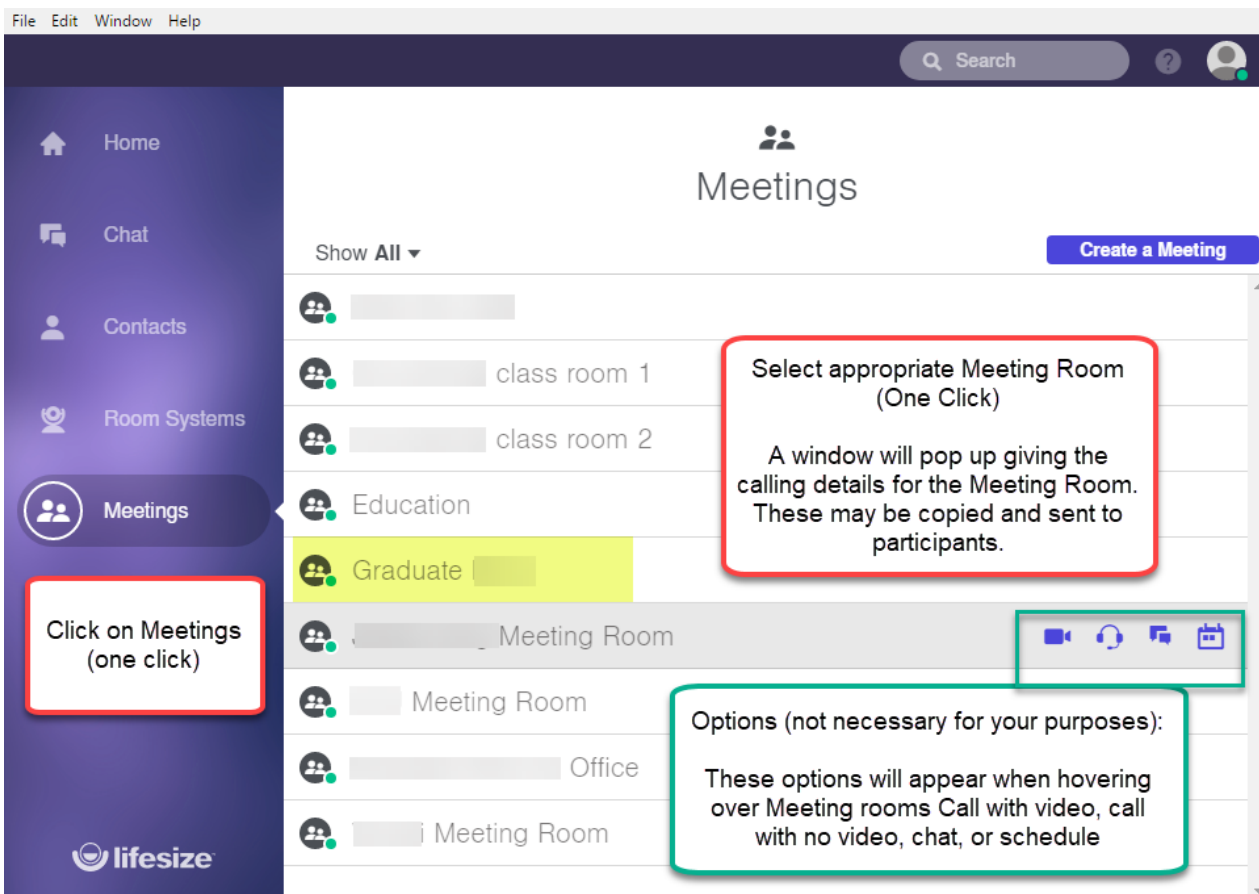
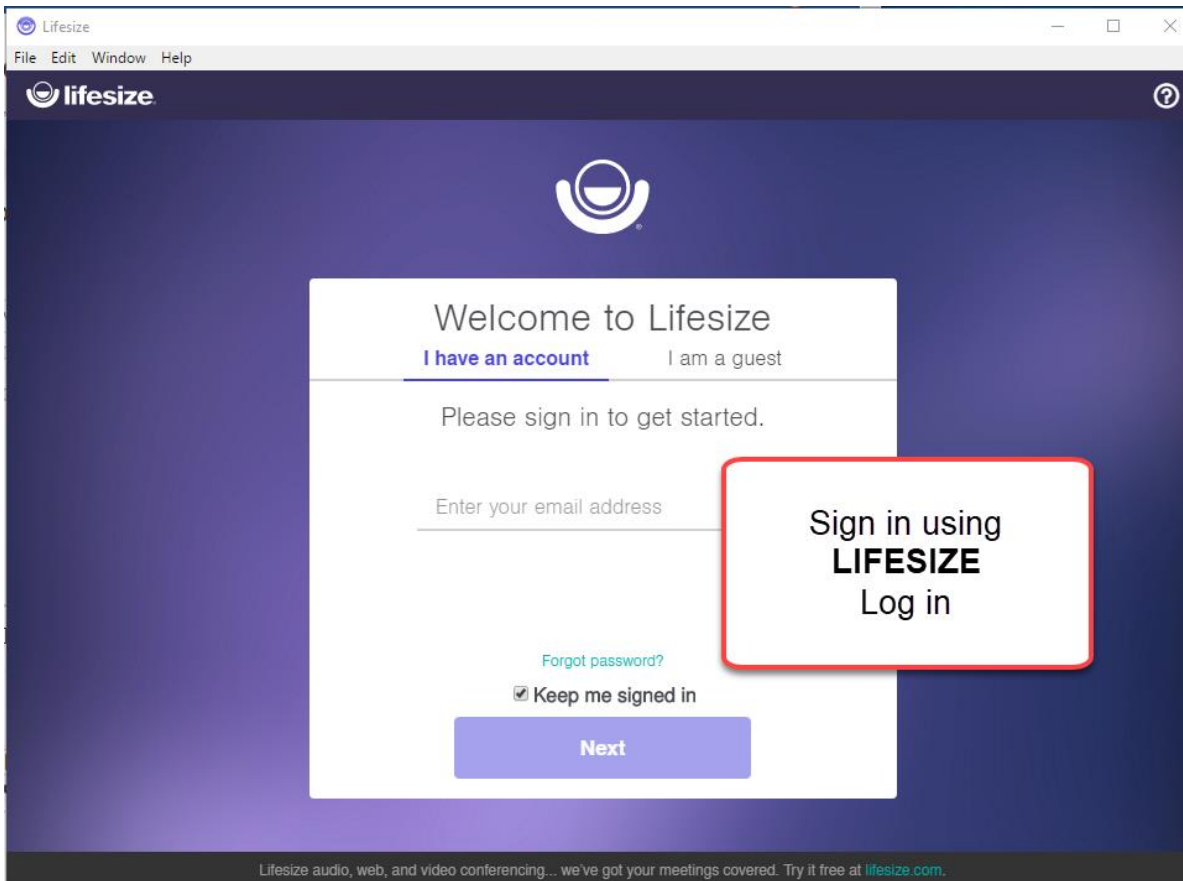
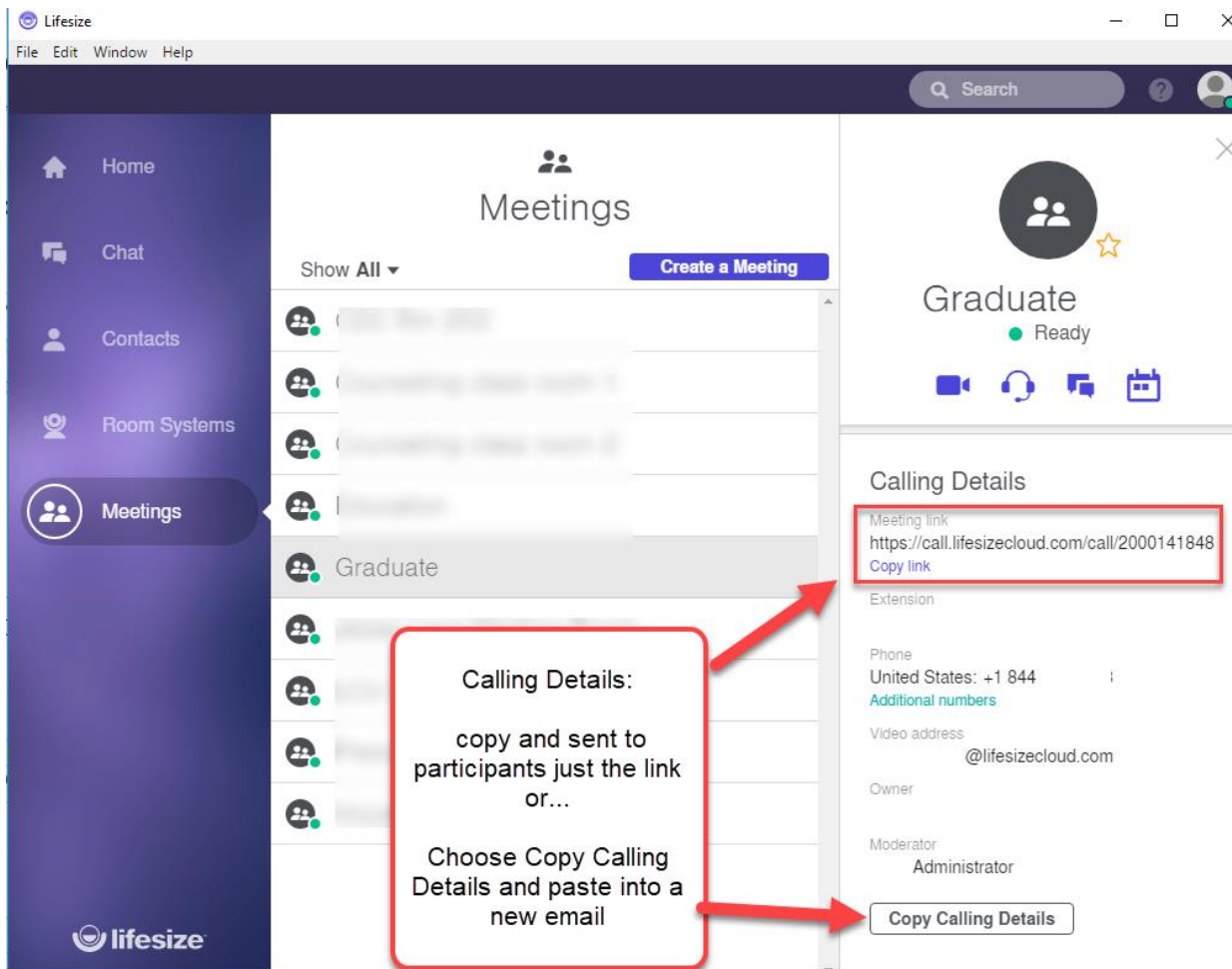
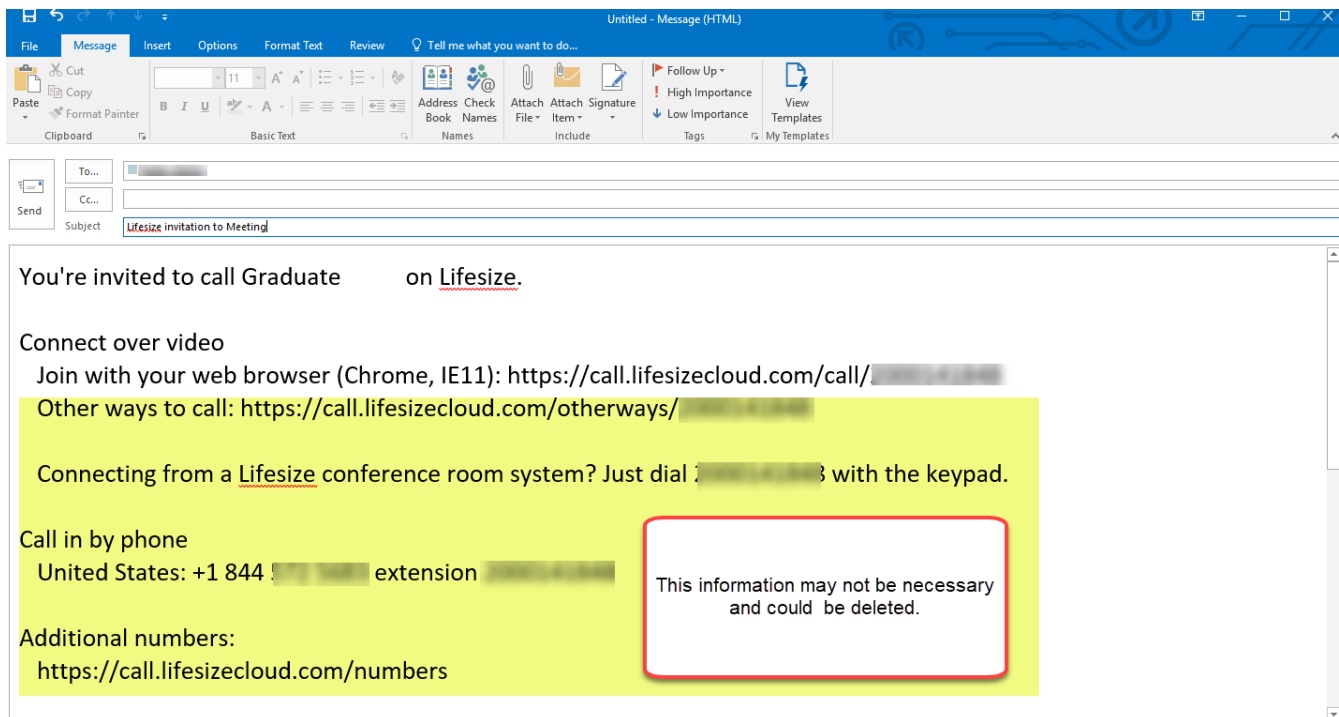


LIFESIZE: Creating a Meeting and Inviting Participants



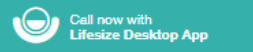


If you choose COPY CALLING DETAILS, the following is a screenshot of what you would see when you paste it into a new email document:



You may want to delete the unnecessary information, but browser information is provided. Also if a listen only is desired, include that participants should turn off their microphones.

When the COPY LINK is pasted into CHROME browser, this is the view participants will see.

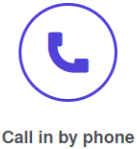
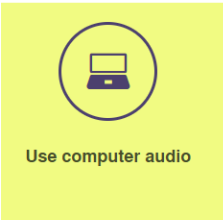
Participants type their name, so presenter knows who has joined the meeting.
