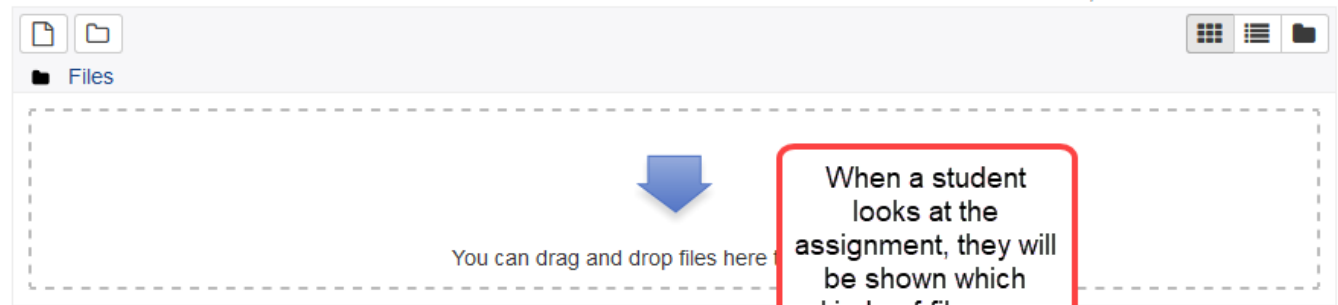

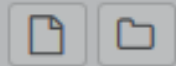
When a student looks at the assignment, they will be shown which kinds of files are accepted.
